

Criminal Misc. Case No. 214 of 2026

This is an application under Section 482 of BNSS, filed by the accused/ petitioners namely; **1. Abdul Sattar, 2. Khaijan Mustafa, 3. Gulapsa Parveen, 4. Abdul Aktar and 5. Nasiman Bibi**, praying for anticipatory bail apprehending their arrest, in connection with Jhalda P.S Case No. 16 of 2026 dated 16.02.2026 under Sections 85/89/115(2)/3(5) of BNS & 3 / 4 of D.P Act, vide G.R. Case No. 299 of 2026.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is moved by the Ld. Lawyer for the accused petitioners.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused submits that no bail application has been filed/pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta. The present accused petitioners are innocent and falsely implicated in this case. There is omnibus allegation against the present accused petitioners. Accordingly, Ld. Lawyer for the accused prays for bail.

Ld. P.P. opposes the bail prayer.

Considered the submissions made by both the sides. Perused the T.C.R., F.I.R and CD. There is omnibus allegation against the present accused petitioners. Considering the nature of allegations and other materials in CD, I do not find any necessity for custodial interrogation of these accused persons for the purpose of investigation. Hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail is considered and allowed.

In the event of arrest, the accused petitioners be released, on furnishing bond of Rs.4000/- each with two sureties of Rs.2000/- each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and on compliance with the conditions as envisaged u/s 482(2) of BNSS.

The Criminal Misc. Case is, thus disposed of. Return the C.D.
