

**Criminal Misc Case No. 216 of 2026**

**Order No. 02**

**09.03.2026**

This is an application under Section 483 of BNSS, filed by the accused/ petitioner namely; **Sahan Rajwar**, praying for bail, in connection with Purulia(M) P.S Case No. 70 of 2026 dated 01.03.2026 under Sections 303(2)/317(2) of BNS & 21(1)(4) of Mines & Minerals (R & D) Act 1957, vide G.R. Case No. 380 of 2026.

Heard the bail prayer made by the Ld. Lawyer for the accused.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused submits that no bail application has been filed/pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

Heard the Ld. PP who raises objection.

Perused the CD and other materials on record.

Having consulting with the case record as well as the materials on the case diary, it appears that the search and seizure against the applicant/accused seeking bail have already been completed and the I.O did not seek for any custodial interrogation of the applicant/accused during his detention in the J/C for the purpose of investigation. In such circumstances, I find that the further detention of the applicant/accused in the J/C for the purpose of investigation is not required. Considering the entire scenario, I am inclined to enlarge the accused on bail.

The accused person may find bail of Rs.3000/- with two registered sureties of Rs. 1500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M, Purulia.

The Criminal Misc. Case is, thus disposed of. Return the C.D.
