

Criminal Misc. Case No. 226 of 2026

This is an application under Section 482 of BNSS, filed by the accused/ petitioner namely; **Fudna Mahato**, praying for anticipatory bail apprehending his arrest, in connection with Purulia(M), P.S Case No. 40 of 2026 dated 30.01.2026 under Section 329(4)/115(2)/117(2)/109/3(5) of BNS, vide G.R. Case No. 183 of 2026.

Heard the bail prayer made by the Ld. Lawyer for the accused.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused submits that no bail application has been filed/pending before the Hon'ble High court, Calcutta.

Perused the CD and other materials on record.

Heard the Ld. P.P. who raises objection.

Having heard the submissions of the Ld. P.P as well as Ld. Defence counsel and having consulting with the case record as well as the materials on the case diary, this is apparent that the dispute between the defacto complainant and the accused person arose from some matrimonial differences and the victim sustained simple injuries over the alleged incident as revealed from page no. 12,14,15,16 and 17 of the CD and the principal accused has already been enlarged on bail. In such circumstances, I find that the custodial interrogation of the applicant/accused seeking anticipatory bail is not required for the purpose of investigation.

In the event of arrest, the accused petitioner be released, on furnishing bond of Rs.5000/- with two registered sureties of Rs. 2500/- each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and on compliance with the conditions as envisaged u/s 482(2) of BNSS.

The Criminal Misc. Case is, thus disposed of. Return the C.D.
