

**Criminal Misc Case No. 229 of 2026**

**Order No. 02**

**12.03.2026**

This is an application under Section 483 of BNSS, filed by the accused/ petitioners namely; **1. Muktar Sai and 2. Sher Shah**, praying for bail, in connection with Tamna P.S Case No. 21 of 2026 dated 11.02.2026 under Sections 126(2)/115(2)/117(2)/118(1)/118(2)/109/3(5) of BNSS, vide G.R. Case No. 267 of 2026.

Heard the bail prayer made by the Ld. Lawyer for the accused.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused submits that no bail application has been filed/pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

Heard the Ld. PP who raises objection.

Perused the CD and other materials on record.

Having consulting with the case record as well as the materials on the case diary, it appears that the applicants/accused persons have been languishing in the J/C for a considerable period of time and the I.O did not seek for any police remand or custodial interrogation of the applicants/accused persons for the purpose of investigation. In such circumstances, I find that the further detention of the applicants/accused persons in the J/C for the purpose of investigation seems unjustified. Considering the entire scenario, I am inclined to enlarge the accused persons on bail.

The accused persons may find bail of Rs.5000/- each with two registered sureties of Rs. 2500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M, Purulia and on condition that the application/accused will not tamper the prosecution witnesses.

The Criminal Misc. Case is, thus disposed of. Return the C.D.
