

Criminal Misc Case No. 234 of 2026

This is an application under Section 483 of BNSS, filed by the accused/ petitioner namely; **Saddam Ansari**, praying for bail, in connection with Barabazar P.S Case No. 10 of 2026 dated 14.01.2026 under Sections 25/27 Arms Act, vide G.R. Case No. 82 of 2026.

Heard the bail prayer made by the Ld. Lawyer for the accused.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused submits that no bail application has been filed/pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

Heard the Ld. PP.

Perused the case record.

It appears from the case record that the search and seizure of the fire arms and ammunition against the applicant/accused seeking bail have already been completed and the applicant/ accused has been detained in the J/C for the considerable period of time and the I.O did not seek for any further custodial interrogation of the applicant/accused during his detention in the J/C for the purpose of investigation. In such circumstances, I find that the custodial interrogation of the applicant/accused seeking bail is not required at this juncture for the purpose of investigation. This is further apparent from the case record that the C.D has already been called for by this Court and the same is not produced before this Court by the investigating agency for ensuring the further detention of the accused person in the J/C. Considering the entire scenario and the detention of the applicant/accused in the J/C, I am inclined to allow the bail prayer of the accused.

The accused person may find bail of Rs.3000/- with two registered sureties of Rs. 1500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M, Purulia and on condition to meet the I.O once in a fortnight until further order.

The Criminal Misc. Case is, thus disposed of.
