ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT D-44

(Delivered on the 08th day of the month of June, of the year 2026).

This is an application filed by the Accused no. 1 for permission to leave the country at Exhibit D-44.

2. APP has endorsed her say objecting to the present application and stated that the Accused may not be available for trial and there is chances to flew from justice by jumping bail.

3. Heard Learned Adv for the Accused No. 1 and Learned APP for the State. Perused the records.

4. It is the case of the Accused No. 1 that he desires to go to Malaysia to visit his mother-in-law, who is not keeping well due to her ill health and the doctor has said that she is in her final days and she needs a care giver to help her in her daily living activities. Accused No. 1 also has to take his son to Delhi for treatment. It is further case of the Accused No. 1 that he undertakes to appear before the Court as and when directed by the Court.

5. It is further case of the Accused No. 1 that his lawyer will be present in the Court during the hearings of the case within the period of absence and that he does not dispute his identity.

6. The present matter is at the stage of evidence. Earlier, the same application was filed by the Accused No. 1 for permission to leave the Country and permission was granted upon executing Personal Bond of Rs. 10,000/- with one local surety in the like amount on 04.10.2025. The Accused No. 1 has requested to continue with the same surety given on 04.10.2025. Accused No. 1 has undertaken to remain present as and when required by the Court. The matter is now

fixed on 10.08.2026. Accused No. 1 has undertaken to return before the next date of hearing. Accused No. 1 has also placed medical report of his son. He has also placed his tickets to show that he is arriving at Goa on 06.08.2026. Accused No. 1 has given the details of his stay at Malaysia. In these circumstances, Accused No. 1 cannot be denied permission. Hence, the Accused No.1 is granted permission to leave the Country from 04.07.2026 to 06.08.2026 with conditions. In view of the same, I pass the following:

ORDER

- a. The application is granted.
- b. Permission is granted to Accused No. 1 to leave the Country from 04.07.2026 to 06.08.2026.
- c. The surety given on 04.10.2025 shall be continued.
- d. Accused No. 1 shall remain present on 10.08.2026 at 2.30 p.m.
