Both the petitioners are present along with their appointed learned advocates on this day fixed for hearing of the application u/s 28 of Special Marriage Act filed by them on 17.08.22.

The endeavor made by this court for reconciliation between the parties failed.

The two affidavits pretending to be examination-in-chief of the petitioner No. 1/ husband Sri Asit Ghorai and petitioner No. 2/wife Smt Riya Kandar have been submitted this day. Same are tendered in evidence and the witnesses are further examined on dock as PW-1 & PW-2 and discharged.

Now, the case record is taken up for passing order.

This is an application u/s 28 of Special Marriage Act filed by petitioners praying for passing decree of divorce on mutual consent. The case of petitioners is that marriage in between them have been solemnised on 15.06.21 under Special Marriage Act. After the marriage they lived together at the house of husband at village-Lakshmanchak, PO- Goura, PS-Daspur, Dist-Paschim Medinipur as husband and wife till 20.07.21 within jurisdiction of this court. On 20.07.21 petitioner No. 2/wife left her matrimonial house and since then has been living separately at village-Nabin Manua, PO- Sitapur, PS-Daspur, Dist.- Paschim Medinipur. In spite of all efforts they failed to reconcile their relation.

From the averments made in the application, the testimony of petitioners on dock and the documents submitted by them it is found that marriage in between them have been solemnised on 15.06.21 under Special Marriage Act. After the marriage they lived together at the house of husband at village-Lakshmanchak, PO- Goura, PS-Daspur, Dist-Paschim Medinipur as husband and wife till 20.07.21 within jurisdiction of this court. On 20.07.21 petitioner No. 2/wife left

her matrimonial house and since then has been living separately at village-Nabin Manua, PO- Sitapur, PS-Daspur, Dist.- Paschim Medinipur. In spite of all efforts they failed to reconcile their relation. The application u/s 28 of Special Marriage Act has been filed on 17.08.22.

Upon consideration I find no impediment in allowing the petition.

Hence, it is ordered

That the application u/s 28 of Special Marriage Act be and the same is allowed.

The marriage solemnized in between the parties on 15.06.21 under Special Marriage Act is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce with immediate effect.
