“Thus it is to conclude that the accused A1 has been the sole author and perpetrator of the offence and that he has committed the offence punishable under section 325 of the Indian Penal Code and he is convicted under section 235(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code.

The convict is stated about the quantum of probable sentence and punishment prescribed under the law.

Put up today at 2 P.M for hearing on the point of sentence and till then the convict is to be kept under segregation at a solitary place for reflection of his mind .”

Record is taken up for hearing on the point of Sentenced to be imposed upon the Convict.

Heard Ld. Spl.P.P. as well as Ld. Defence Counsel.

Sentence is ready with the record and the same is signed sealed and pronounced in open Court in presence of the accused person and both the Ld. Lawyers.

The operative part of the Sentence is as follows:-

“Keeping in view that convict is sentenced to suffer Imprisonment for a period already undergone during trial of this case and to pay a fine of Rs.20,000/-, for the offence punishable under Section 325 of the Indian Penal Code. In default of payment of fine amount, the convict shall undergo Simple Imprisonment for a period of 6 Months.

The fine amount, when realised, shall be given to the victim child survivor as compensation and for her future welfare.

A copy of this order be sent to District Magistrate, Purulia and Superintendent of Police, Purulia for information and taking necessary action.

The convict is informed that he has a right to prefer an appeal against this judgment. He has been apprised that if he cannot afford to engage any Ld. Advocate, he can approach the Legal Aid Cell, functioning in the correctional home where the convict shall be housed or write to Secretary, Hon’ble Calcutta High Court Legal Services Committee for free legal assistance.

A copy of judgment and copy of order on sentence be supplied free of cost to convict against receipt.

Let another copy be sent to Legal Service Committee, Hon’ble High Court, Calcutta and Chairman, District Legal Services Authority, Purulia.”
