The plaintiffs have moved an application for ad interim injunction and also moved an application for local inspection.

It appears from the report of the Sheristadar In-Charge that no caveat has been filed and is pending till date in the present suit.

Accordingly, the case record is taken up for hearing of the ad interim injunction prayer of the plaintiffs.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the plaintiffs.

Perused the plaint, injunction application as well as documents filed by the plaintiffs.

Considered.

Upon careful perusal of the plaint, the temporary injunction application and also after going through the documents filed on behalf of the plaintiffs, this Court is not inclined to pass any order of ad interim injunction against the defendant nos.1 to 5 without granting the said defendants an opportunity of hearing. This Court also does not find any such urgency at this stage to grant an order of ad interim injunction against the defendant nos.1 to 5 without notice.

Hence, it is,

O R D E R E D

that the prayer for ad interim injunction is refused at this stage against the defendant nos.1 to 5 without notice.

Issue notice upon the defendant nos.1 to 5, directing them to show cause within 14 days of receipt of notice as to why the temporary injunction application shall not be heard against them.

Plaintiffs to file requisites at once.

The application for local inspection dated 03.08.2026 filed on behalf of the plaintiffs shall be considered by this Court after service of notice of the same upon the defendants.
