: JUDGMENT:

(Delivered on 25.02.2019)

1. Accused stands prosecuted for the offence under Section offences punishable under Section 283 IPC, 102, 117 Bombay Police Act, 1887. They are found selling fruits on footpath on the public road. The particulars of the offence read over and explained to the accused.

2. The only question therefore arised for me.

i)	Whether the accused persons pleaded guilty voluntarily ?	Yes
ii)	Whether the leniency be shown to him ?	Yes

3. I answered these points in the affirmative for the reasons stated below.

: R E A S O N S:

4. The accused pleaded guilty to the charge. Considering the nature of offence, plea of the accused and application on record, if any, I think it is voluntarily made and hence I accept the plea of accused being voluntarily. Accused submitted repenting upon the act and hence prayed for leniency while passing sentence. Thus considering facts and circumstances of the case, nature of offence, I have taken lenient view and proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The accused is convicted under Section 252 of the Criminal Procedure Code for the offence punishable under Section 283 IPC, 102, 117 Bombay Police Act, 1887 and sentenced to pay fine of Rs.300/- (**Rs. Three Hundred Only**) in default to undergo simple imprisonment for 1 day.
