The case record is put up today on the basis of put up petition filed by the Ld. Spl. P.P Sri Asit Banerjee for moving the prayer for an order for disposal of the contraband.

Ld. Spl. P.P annexed with his petition an application of SI Joydev Gorai of Joypur PS duly forwarded by the Inspector-in-charge of Joypur PS praying for an order for disposal of the seized properties lying at Cental Narcotic Drug Godown, Purulia since long in connection with Joypur PS Case no. 117/23 dated 16-09-2023 under Section 21(c) of the NDPS Act.

The Ld. Spl. P.P submitted that in this case **01 white colour plastic jarican with red colour cap containing 12540 gram (including jarican) of light-rad colour codeine mixture (mother)** was seized and sent to Cental Narcotic Drug Godown Malkhana, Purulia as per order no.01 dated 18-09-2023 by this Court. The Ld. Spl. P.P also submitted that in this case inventory by the Ld. Magistrate was not done under Section 52A of the NDPS Act. Again the Ld. Spl. P.P submitted that the mother contraband is still kept at Cental Narcotic Drug Godown Malkhana, Purulia the Court Malkhana at Purulia and the chemical examination report of the sample has been received vide Report no. SDCRL/126/Narcotic/2024-2025 has been received as positive for the presence of codeine. Thus, the Ld. Spl. P.P prayed for an order of disposal of the mother contraband at the earliest.

After hearing submission of Ld. Spl. P.P and having gone through the case record it is deciphered that this case 01 white colour plastic jarican with red colour cap containing 12540 gram (including jarican) of light-rad colour codeine mixture (mother) was recovered and seized. Thereafter, sample collected from the seized bottles were sent to SDCRL for chemical examination and the report has already been received. It is pertinent to note here that sample was collected in presence of the Ld. Magistrate under Section 52 A of the NDPS Act. However, since more than 30 days have elapsed from the date of receipt of the chemical examination report of the sample I do not find any impediment to allowed the prayer of the IO of this case for passing necessary order for disposal of the seized contraband of this case.

Hence, it is,

**ORDERED**

that the petition of IO of this case for passing order for disposal of the seized contraband is allowed.

The Office-in-charge of Joypur PS is directed to act accordingly for disposal of the seized alamat except samples at the earliest and to submit a report regarding such disposal by the next date.

The Chairman of Drug Disposal Committee, Purulia is hereby requested to take initiative to make entry in the DDMS portal with regard to the kind of disposal of the aforesaid seized alamat.

Let a copy of this order be supplied to the Office-in-charge of Joypur PS for information and compliance.
