EXAMINATION-IN-CHIEF BY THE LEARNED SPECIAL P.P:-

1. On 07.11.2023, while I was on my duty in the office of Joint Commissioner, Commercial Taxes, DGSTO-3, Bengaluru at about 3.00 P.M., I was informed by the office in-charge officer by name Nataraj to go to NIA office, Indiranagar. Accordingly, the SDA Sri Siddaraju (CW.2) and I went to NIA office, Indiranagar on the same day at about 10.00 P.M. In the NIA office, the Dy.SP introduced himself to us and told us that Bangladesh nationals have come and residing illegally in Bengaluru and we were asked to accompany them to the said place where the said Bangladesh nationals have been illegally residing.
2. The NIA police sub inspector, the NIA women police staff members and other NIA police staff members and Siddaraju (CW.2) and I left the NIA office at 03.30 A.M (in the Night) and reached the garbage dumping yard at Horamavu Main Road, Seegehalli, Bengaluru at 05.30 A.M (in the early morning).

3. The other team from NIA also arrived in the said place. We all reached a Tarpaulin shed situated in the middle of the said garbage dumping yard at 06.00 A.M. When the NIA police sub-inspector knocked the door of the said shed, one person came from the said shed. The NIA police sub-inspector informed the said person who came from the said shed that we are from NIA and we subjected ourselves to personal search in the presence of the said person to ensure that we did not have any articles relating to this case with us. The said person who came from the said shed introduced himself as Mirazul.
4. I can identify said Mirazul if he is shown to me. Witness identifies accused No.8 Md Mirazul who is produced from Central Prison, Bengaluru through V.C. In the said shed two Aadhar cards, one mobile with SIM, one packet containing three SIM cards, one PAN card, one bank passbook, one ATM card and one Kerala State Driving License were found on a table in the said shed. The NIA police sub-inspector packed the said articles and documents with covers and seized them in our presence. Search and seizure proceedings was conducted in our presence.
5. I can identify the said search and seizure proceedings. The witness identifies the said search and seizure proceedings (search list) and his signature on it. Hence, the said search and seizure proceedings is marked as **Ex.P.1** and signature of witness is marked as **Ex.P.1(a)**.
6. I can identify the said seized articles and documents. The witness identifies 3 Aadhar cards, PAN card, ATM card, Driving License, Bank passbook, rental agreement, 2 empty AIRTEL pouches. Hence, they are marked as **Ex.P.2** to **Ex.P.11** respectively.
7. CW.2 Siddaraju, accused No.8 Mirazul and also NIA sub-inspector signed the said search and seizure proceedings. The search and

seizure proceedings was concluded around 08.00 A.M. In the said place the NIA police sub-inspector recorded my statement. We alongwith accused N.8 Mirazul returned to NIA office.
