The case record is taken up for hearing of the bail petition u/s 483 of BNSS, filed by the accused/ petitioner namely; **Jaleswari Tudu**, in connection with Para PS Case No.182 of 2025 dated 20.10.2025 u/s 103/3(5) BNS, GR Case No. 790 of 2025.

The submission of the learned counsel for the accused is heard. It is stated that the accused, being a woman, has been in custody since 21.10.2025. It is further pointed out that the other co-accused persons in the present case have already been granted bail. The charge sheet has also been filed against ten accused persons, including the present accused, under Sections 103(1)/3(5) of the BNS. Considering the period of her detention and taking into account that she is a female accused, it is prayed that she be released on bail on such terms and conditions as may be deemed fit and proper.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused further submits that no bail application has been filed/pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

Ld. PP raises strong objection.

Upon going through the case diary and the statements of witnesses recorded under Sections 180 and 183 of the BNS, it is revealed that the present accused has been specifically implicated as the person who dealt the fatal blow to the victim. The materials further disclose that the weapon allegedly used in the commission of the offence was recovered during the period of police custody of this accused. Having regard to these circumstances and the nature of the allegations reflected in the case diary, the prayer for bail of the accused is **rejected**.

Return the CD.

Thus, the Cr. Misc. Case is disposed of.
