Matter received by way of transfer from Digital Court No. 6 as per order No. 44542-44581/Cases Tsfr./Digital Courts/Judl./DWK/2025 dated 19.11.2025 of Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge (S-W), Dwarka Courts, New Delhi.

Ld. counsel for complainant has submitted the physical file alongwith copy of previous ordersheets. Same are taken on record.

Notice under section 251 Cr.P.C framed against the accused to which he pleaded not guilty and claims trial.

It appears that in case the accused is tried and found guilty for the offence, he is likely to be punished for imprisonment upto two years. In view of the same, let the present case be tried as Summons Triable case.

During the course of framing of notice, accused has admitted that the cheque in question belongs to his account and the genuineness of the return memo.

At this stage, Ld. counsel for the complainant submits that he has no objection if the witnesses mentioned at serial no. 2 to 3 are dropped.

Basis the defence of the accused at the stage of framing of notice, oral application u/s 145 (2) N.I. Act stands allowed.

At this stage, both the parties submits that they want to explore the possibility of settlement and request is made for referring the matter to mediation cell. Accordingly, both the parties are directed to appear before the Mediation Cell

after obtaining mediation referral order and appending their signatures on the same. Parties are directed to remain present before the mediation cell on 26.02.2026 at 12:00 p.m. Ahlmad is directed to do the needful.

Put up for report on compromise (if any)/CE/ further proceedings on 28.04.2026.
