Harpal Singh in a case **FIR no. 90, Dated 04.04.2026, under Section 25/27 Arms Act**, registered at **P.S. Jandiala, Amritsar**.

Perusal of record shows accused is in custody since 04.04.2026. Hence, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused in jail for an indefinite period. Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, the present regular bail application is allowed and accused is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) That accused shall not indulge in the offence of similar nature.
- (ii) That accused shall not induce, give threat, pressure to the prosecution witness.
- (iii) That accused shall come present on each date of hearing.
- (iv) That the accused shall not leave country without permission of the Court.

Bail bonds and surety bonds not furnished. **Further, in light of the order dated 31.01.2023 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, New Delhi in SMWP (Criminal) No. 4/21 of Point No. (1) mentioned at page no. 9, Ahlmad concered is directed to send a soft copy of bail order by e-mail to the prisoner/applicant through Jail Superintendent Concerned, forthwith** Papers be attached with the remand papers.
