At this stage, it is submitted by Sh. Ramesh Sharma/ LR of DH that due to inadvertence his appearance has been recorded as Ld. Counsel for JD no. 3 on 11.05.2026 and 19.05.2025 and that he has already been transposed as the DH in the present matter.

Heard. In view of facts and circumstances, order dated 19.05.2026 stands modified to the extent that cost of Rs. 3000/- be paid to the DH and Ld. Counsel for JDs no. 2 and 5 (totaling to a cost of Rs. 6000/). Rest of the order dated 19.05.2026 remains the same.

Cost of Rs. 3000/- paid to the DH as Ld. Counsel for JD no. 2 and 5 each.

Matter is listed for consideration on the application u/s 151 CPC for recall/setting aside order dated 21.02.2026 and for restoration of objections as matter of last and final opportunity.

At this stage, Ld. Counsel Sh. Hunny Singh on behalf of JD no. 1 seeks to withdraw his vakalatnama. Heard. As JD no. 1 is present in court the same is intimated to him and Ld. Counsel stands discharged accordingly.

In view of the same, clarification sought from JD no. 1 who submits that he wishes to argue in the present application under Section 151 CPC himself without any legal assistance.

Submissions heard.

At this stage, JD no. 1 seeks to file a rejoinder to the present application, however, as no permission was sought to file earlier and the same is not a statutory right, arguments already being concluded by both the parties, the same is not taken on record however, the JD no. 1 is at liberty to file written submissions within two days from today with advance copy to the opposite party.
