Sole accused is absent by petition.

The registered owner of the seized vehicle namely, Ashok Mishra s/o Late Sonelal Mishra of Vill-Santa, Dist. Paschim Burdwan.

The I.O of this case has submitted a report on 25.02.2025 stating inter alia that the registered owner namely, Ashok Mishra s/o Late Sonelal Mishra of Vill-Santa, Dist. Paschim Burdwan is the registered owner of the seized TVS Motor Cycle bearing registration no. WB38Q3835. However, the I.O of this case, has raised no objection in the matter of return of the seized Truck bearing registration no. WB38Q3835 to its registered owner or as the court deems fit.

One petition to return the vehicle is filed by registered owner namely Ashok Mishra s/o Late Sonelal Mishra of Vill-Santa, Dist. Paschim Burdwan, TVS Motor Cycle bearing registration no. WB38Q3835.

The case record reflects that the vehicle has been seized since long.

Considering the entire scenario, I do not find any justification for detaining the seized TVS Motor Cycle bearing registration no. WB38Q3835.

Hence, the registered owner of seized vehicle has to furnish personal PR bond of Rs. 1,50,000/- for getting return of the seized TVS Motor Cycle bearing registration no. WB38Q3835. With a condition as per law.
