Record is taken up on the strength of one put up petition filed by Ld Advocate representing **accused Sujit Mukherjee**.

The accused is taken into custody.

The accused files a petition praying for acceptance of plea of guilt.

Charge-sheet has been submitted against the accused person under Section 153 and 147 Rly Act.

Accordingly, the record is taken up for examination of the accused under Section-240 of Cr.P C 1973.

The substance of accusation in respect of the offences under Section 153 and 147 Rly Act have been read over and explained to accused and he was asked whether he pleads guilty or not, during which time he has pleaded guilty after knowing its true import. The plea of guilt seems to have been made voluntarily.

That being so, this court is inclined to accept the plea of guilt of the accused and pass the sentence of conviction against the accused person in accordance with the provisions laid down u/s-241 of Cr.P.C.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED

that the accused person, namely, **Sujit Mukherjee** is hereby convicted in accordance with the provisions laid down under Section- 153 and 147 Rly Act and sentenced to **pay fine of Rs.650/-** only for the offence punishable under Section- i.d. to suffer simple imprisonment for 10 days.
