

GR Case no.-870/2024

Today is fixed for evidence of CSW nos. 1 and 6.

The sole accused person on C.B is present by filing hazira.

Two witnesses CSW no. 1 Kailash Kumbhakar and CSW no. 6 Neha Kumbhakar are present before this Court today. They are examined and cross-examined in full and discharged as PW1 and PW2 respectively.

During examination the written complaint be marked as Exhibit 1 as a whole. The statement recorded by the Ld. Magistrate of the victim girl i.e. PW2 bar marked as Exhibit 2 as a whole.

No other witness is present today.

On the prayer of the Ld. APP the evidence of prosecution witness is closed.

Now, the case record is taken up for examination of the accused person u/s 313 Cr.P.C., argument and Judgment.

The sole accused person is examined u/s 313 of Cr.P.C. He declines to adduce any evidence in his defence.

Heard argument advanced by both sides in full in first half and the case record is taken up for passing of Judgment in 2nd half.

It is now 10:30 A.M.

The Judgment is ready and it is written in separate sheets and tagged with the case record and the order portion is read aloud in open Court.

“Hence, it is,

ORDERED

that the sole accused person namely, Janardan Kumbhakar is found not guilty of the offence punishable under sections 137(2)/140(3) of BNS and accordingly, the sole accused person above named is hereby acquitted from the present police case as well as from all the charges and accusations leveled against him, in terms of the provision enumerated under section 271 of BNSS.

The sole accused person above named is hereby set at liberty and stand discharged from his bail bond.”
