

IA 12/2025 & IA 19/2025 of CBI 287/2019 & CBI 286/2019
CBI VS POSITIVE TELEVISION PVT LTD.
CBI VS NE TELEVISION PVT LTD.

This is an application filed on behalf of applicant accused Nagesh Kumar Behl seeking permission to travel abroad i.e. UK and Belgium from 13.06.2025 to 01.07.2025.

1. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused Nagesh Kumar Behl that applicant is seeking permission to visit abroad i.e. UK and Belgium, from 13.06.2025 to 01.07.2025. The itinerary and contact details of the accused, during his visit abroad has also been furnished.

2. Reply filed on behalf of CBI, wherein formal objection has been raised, to the proposed visit of accused.

3. I have heard the arguments and perused the record.

4. Considering that the right to travel abroad is the fundamental right of a person and the travel of the applicant / accused on the aforementioned dates shall not hamper the course of trial, applicant/ accused Nagesh Kumar Behl, is granted permission to travel to UK and Belgium from 13.06.2025 to 01.07.2025 on the following conditions :

1. That he shall furnish indemnity/security in the form of NSC/FDR/bank Guarantee for a sum of Rs. One Lakh, in each case, which shall be refunded on his return.

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- 2. That he shall not seek extension of his stay abroad on any ground, except on medical grounds.*
- 3. That he shall authorize his Counsel to receive notice on his behalf, during his stay abroad.*
- 4. That he shall properly instruct his counsel for proceeding further in the case during his stay abroad and no adjournment shall be sought by his counsel for lack of instructions from the accused. The accused shall not dispute his identity at a later stage or take the plea of any prejudice having been caused to him due to his absence.*
- 5. In case any of the above conditions is violated, the security/FDR shall stand forfeited.*
- 6. That applicant/accused Nagesh Kumar Behl shall inform about his arrival in India within 7 days of his return to India.*

5. Accordingly, the application of the accused/applicant seeking permission to travel abroad, stands disposed of.
6. It is clarified that this Order shall become operational upon fulfillment of the aforesaid conditions.
7. Copy of this order be also given dasti to Ld. Counsel for applicant/ accused Nagesh Kumar Behl as requested.
8. Re-notify on the date already fixed i.e. **04.08.2025**.
