An application under Section 482 BNSS moved on behalf of
the applicant / accused **Abdul Karim Shah** for grant of transit anticipatory
bail is pending for disposal.

1. It is submitted by the Ld. counsel for the applicant / accused
that petitioner is receiving calls from the concerned IO and he has an
apprehension that he can be arrested and it is only requested that the
applicant / accused be granted relief of transit anticipatory bail to the
applicant / accused for a reasonable period of 30 days to approach the
competent Court in Maharashtra in case arising out of FIR no. 789/2024
dated 19.09.2024, under Section 316 (5) & 318 BNSS and under Section 66
D I.T. Act at PS Shivaji Nagar, Thane City, Maharashtra and hence, it is
prayed that present application be allowed.

2. On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the state has argued on the
present application and strongly opposed the same.

3. It would not be appropriate to consider the allegations and counter allegations at this stage as it may prejudice the case of either party. Rather, it would be in the fitness of things, the Court concerned, who is seized of the matter should look into merit / demerits of the case. The applicant / accused is only claiming protection for a reasonable time to avail legal remedy before the Court at Thane, Maharashtra. Accordingly, this Court deem it appropriate to allow the applicant / accused to avail his legal remedy to approach the concerned Court. Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, IO of FIR no. 789/2024 dated 19.09.2024 of PS Shivaji Nagar, Thane City, Maharashtra shall not take any coercive action against the applicant / accused till **15.02.2026**.

4. Nothing stated herein which shall tantamount to expression of opinion on merits of case and whatever has been stated is only for the purpose of deciding the present application. **Application stands disposed of accordingly.**

5. Copy of this order be given dasti to Ld. counsel for the applicant / accused, as prayed for. Copy of this order be also sent to the IO / Inspector Deepak is present from PS Shivaji Nagar, Thane, Maharashtra through whatsapp for information.
