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I have filed this case against Gopal Ray, s/o Asit Ray. I have a friendly relationship with the accused persons. Out of such relation he helped the accused of Rs. 4,07,000/- (Four lac and seven thousand) in between 04.05.2024 and 09.06.2024 to help him. On 08.08.2024 he issued a cheque of SBI, Kishoreganj Branch, having cheque no. 519384 of amounting Rs. 2,00,000/-. I have deposited the cheque on 12.08.2024 at PNB Bank, Chelyamma branch and the same was dishonoured due to insufficient amount, which I came to know on 19.08.2024 from return memo. Subsequently I issued a demand notice through my Ld. Advocate Supriya Ganguly on 29.08.2024 and the same was received on 02.09.2024. But till today neither payment was made nor any reply was made against my demand notice by the accused person, hence this case.

I pray relief before your Honours court.
