Record is put up on the prayer of the Petitioner.

Ld Adv for both the parties are present before this court.

PW1 has been examined on oath today. In her examination-in-chief, she has categorically stated that she had filed the present case against her son Raycharan Swarnakar, but at present she does not have any allegation against him. She has further stated that the matter has been amicably settled between her and her son, and she does not want to proceed with the case. She has also expressed that she has no objection if the accused is set free and that she intends to withdraw the case voluntarily.

Cross-examination of PW1 has been declined, which implies that no questions were put to the witness by the opposite side.

Upon careful consideration of the deposition of PW1, it appears that the petitioner herself is no longer interested in prosecuting the present proceeding and has voluntarily expressed her intention to withdraw the same. The dispute being personal in nature and having been amicably settled between the parties, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the present proceeding pending.

Accordingly, the prayer for withdrawal of the case is allowed.

Hence, Misc Case No. 126 of 2025 is hereby dismissed as withdrawn, without any liberty to file afresh.

Let the case record be consigned to the record room after due compliance.
