No S/R of summons on CSW-1,2 and 3 is received from the Adra PS.

It appears from the case record that summons upon CSW1, 2 and 3 has been issued on 06.02.2025 having PR No. 281, 282 and 283 but no return is received.

This lackadaisical approach to a summon of this court has actively contributed to the delay of further proceeding of this case and has denied the complainant from getting her legitimate claim. If this basilica is faced with this feigned ignorance on the part of the authority concern in that event the pitiable situation of the litigant public is quite obvious. Considering the factual facet I am left with no option but to raise questions about the gumption of the authority concern, and I have no quandary in harbouring to the conclusion that this kind of laggardness on the part of the O/C Adra must not be patronized. It is not irrational to expect at least a report from the concern P.S on the execution of summon. It is quite unfortunate that this court has to engage itself in reminding the police officer concern about his duties and that he should have sent a report even if he is not able to execute the summon.

Send a copy of this Order Sheet to the Inspector in Charge of Adra PS directing him to ensure Service Return of witness summons sent herewith by next date in default he is to appear in person and account for his failure before Court.
