It is submitted by both the the parties that they have amicably resolved all their disputes before the Mediation Centre, Saket Courts, New Delhi, vide Settlement Agreement dated 04.07.2026, which is taken on record as Ex. A-1. The Judgment Debtors have undertaken to abide by the terms and conditions of the settlement and have also paid the first instalment of Rs. 30,000/- to the Decree Holder today. The Decree Holder, through its AR, has sought permission to withdraw the present execution petition in terms of the settlement. Statements of both the parties have been recorded to this effect.

In view of the statements of the parties and the settlement arrived at between them, the present execution petition is disposed of as withdrawn in terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 04.07.2026 (Ex. A-1). The Decree Holder has also provided his account no. i.e. A/c No. 309810556727, RBL Bank, Name of the Account Holder- Mallika Sharma and IFSC Code-RATN0000100. The Settlement Agreement shall form part of this order.

It is clarified that in the event of breach of the terms of the settlement, it shall be open to the aggrieved party to avail such remedies as are available in law, including enforcement of the

settlement/decreed, in accordance with law.
