Accd Ranjit Das on C.B is present by filing hazira.

Today is fixed for evidence of all the rest witnesses but no witness is present.

Ld. P.P in charge and ld. Defence counsel are present.

At this stage ld. Defence counsel submits that in this case inspite of availing numbers of opportunities to produce all the rest witnesses, prosecution fails to produce any witness resulting which the trial of this case has been delayed.

Ld. P.P in-charge did not submit anything material and left the entire matter upon the discretion of this court.

On scrutiny of the entire materials on record, this court finds that in this case four prosecution witnesses were examined and since thereafter inspite of availing several opportunities prosecution failed to bring any further witness. Besides this the instant case has been arisen out of an incident alleged to be committed in the year 2009.

Thus in the above background, specially considering the age of this case, this court is of view that if further chance be given to the prosecution to bring witness it will led to gross injustice. Thus the evidence of prosecution is closed today.
