Order No. 20, dated 07.01.2026

The record is taken up for fresh steps by the petitioner.

Petitioner files a petition on affidavit u/o-5 Rule 20 read with section 151 of C.P.C. praying for service of summons upon the respondent by substituted manner through paper publication along with copy of RTI application, original postal receipt, E-track report and RTI matter of furnished information having No. CPT/RTI Offline/1001/2022 dated Kolkata-124, the 07.03.2022.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner moves the said petition stating that the petitioner has issued summons via speed post through postal department and the same was delivered to the parental residential address of the respondent but the respondent has not appeared till date.

As such the petitioner has filed this petition for servicing summons through paper publication.

Heard. Perused the petition and materials on record. It is seen that the summons in respect of service upon the respondent is complete through postal department..

Following the fact, it seems to me that the petitioner has no other alternative but to publish the notice of the instant suit in any daily newspaper regarding service of summons. That being position, I am inclined to allow the said petition .

Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the petition u/o-5 Rule 20 read with section 151 of C.P.C. is allowed.

Let, the summon be advertised in any widely circulated daily newspaper which has circulation in the residential address area of the respondent or in the area where she works for gain and in language the respondent can understand.

The petitioner is directed to submit the draft petition for paper publication on the next date.
