State Vs. Prasanta Sardar & Other

Out of three accused persons two accused persons namely Prasanta Sardar and Sagar Sardar are produced from J.C through VCS.

Accused Narayan Sardar @ Naran on bail is present by filing hazira.

Two separate bail petitions have been filed on behalf of accused Prasanta Sardar and accused Sagar Sardar alongwith fresh vokalatnama of accused Sagar Sardar.

Heard both sides.

Learned advocate for accused persons submit that these accused persons are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. One of the accused persons is already on bail. The accused persons are the permanent resident within jurisdiction of this Court and there is no chance of their abscondance. No bail prayer is either pending or rejected before any higher forum. Accused persons may be enlarged on bail imposing any terms and conditions.

Learned Special P.P-in-Charge raises objection.

Perused the materials on record and in case diary as well statement of VG recorded u/s 164 of Cr.P.C and her medical report.

Considering the materials in CD, period of detention of accused persons and development in investigation I find that further detention of these accused persons is not required for the purpose of investigation. Accordingly, bail prayers of accused Prasanta Sardar and Sagar Sardar stand allowed.

Accused persons namely Prasanta Sardar and Sagar Sardar may find bail of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees ten thousand only) each with two registered sureties of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) each subject to satisfaction of learned C.J.M Alipore with condition that they shall meet the I.O once a week for next two months and shall not induce or threaten the VG and witnesses of this case, or tamper with evidence, in default to J.C.

If on bail to 08.06.2022 for appearance of accused persons and I.O's report.
