The case record is put up on the prayer of the accused Sk. Salim who surrendered before the Court by filing a petition along with Vakalatnama and prayed for bail.

He is taken into custody and remanded to J.C for fourteen days.

Learned Advocate for the accused submits that this accused has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court u/Sec.482 BNSS in CMC No. 701 of 2026. Today he has voluntarily surrendered before this Court and prayed for regular bail.

Learned Special PP-in-Charge left the matter to the discretion of the Court.

I have heard both sides. Perused the materials on record and the petition as well.

It appears from the record that this accused person has been granted bail by this Court u/Sec.482 BNSS vide Order No.3 dated 02.03.2026 in CMC No. 701 of 2026. In view of the said order and considering the submission of both sides, I am inclined to release this accused on bail. Hence the bail prayer of the accused stands allowed.

Accordingly, accused Sk. Salim may find bail of **Rs.5,000/- (rupees five thousand only) with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- (rupees two thousand five hundred only) each** subject to the satisfaction of Ld. CJM, Alipore with condition that he shall cooperate with the IO during investigation of this case and the accused will appear before this Court on each and every date of hearing i.d. to J/C.

If on bail, to date i.e. **21.08.2026** for appearance of accused and IO's report.
