Ld. P.P in charge and ld. Defence counsel are present.

An intimation has been sent from Superintendent Baruipur Central Correctional Home stating therein that due to engagement of vehicle and large number of police personnel in Higher Secondary, Secondary and Madrasah examination, the accd could not be produced today and in such facts & situation Superintendent Baruipur Central Correctional Home further prays for production of the accd through V.C.

It is pertinent to mention here that presently the V.C set up of this court is not functioning and therefore accd persons are required to be produced physically before this Court. Besides this due to non production of the accd persons, this court has been compelled to release the witness without examination. In this facts & circumstances Superintendent Baruipur Central Correctional Home is directed to produce the accd persons physically on the next date fixed only for the sake of smooth trial of this case.

Fix 17.2.2026 for further cross examination of PW-1 and for production of the accd persons.

Prosecution to produce alamats as well as witness.

Inform Superintendent Baruipur Central Correctional Home by sending a copy of this order at once for its compliance.

By filing a petition ld. Advocate representing the convicts Ajoy Mondal and Basudev Roy submits that Hon'ble Court Calcutta has been pleased to grant bail in favour of the aforesaid convicts in c/w CRA (SB) 78 of 2024 with CRAN 1 of 2024.

In support of this contention, a certified copy of the order of the Hon'ble Court passed in CRA (SB) 78 of 2024 with CRAN 1 of 2024 vide order dtd 8.7.2024 is placed before this court.

From the certified copy of the order it is found that the Hon'ble Court has been pleased to pass the following order :

“Accordingly, the appellants are directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court upon furnishing two local sureties for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each on the condition that the appellants shall be represented on all the subsequent dates before this Court on which the appeal would be taken up for hearing.”

The aforesaid order of the Hon’ble Court is reflected in the official website of Hon’ble Court.

As per direction of Hon’ble Court Calcutta local sureties on behalf of both the convicts filed their respective bail bonds along with necessary documents.

Concerned staff is directed to fit the bail bond of local sureties and send a report to that effect.
