A vokatnama has been filed on behalf of the accused person. Let it be accepted and kept with record. One bail application has also been filed. Ld. Advocate prays for time to move the application for bail. Accordingly the bail prayer is kept in abeyance.

I.O of this case has made prayer for JC of this accused.

Another prayer filed by the IO is considered and allowed.

Learned A.C.J.M, Alipore is requested to record the statement of the ***victim girl and the complainant*** u/s 183 BNSS either personally or by deputing any other Magistrate within 48 hours following the procedure as laid down in section 25 and 26 of the POCSO Act, 2012 and to forward the same to this Court without undue delay. In view of the direction of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta vide Judgment dated 16.12.2021 delivered by the Hon'ble Justice Bibek Chawdhuri in **CRA 517 of 2017 (Prabir Bhuian Alias Prabir Bhuinyan Vs The State of West Bengal)** the learned Magistrate is also requested to take care and to take necessary steps so that the identity of the victim girl is not disclosed during recording of the statement of the victim girl and the complainant.

The I.O. of this case is directed to produce the victim girl and the complainant before the Ld. Magistrate for recording their statement.

Fix **17.03.2026** for production of the accused from JC, hearing of bail application and I.O's report.
