Accused Md. Hamid @ Guru (63 years) is produced before this Court from J/C through VCS.

Today is fixed for hearing of the bail application filed on behalf of the accused on 06.03.2026. The same is taken up for hearing in presence of both sides.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person has submitted that the accused has falsely been implicated in this case and he is innocent. Ld. Advocate has further submitted that his client is in custody for a considerable period. Thus, he prayed for bail of the accused in any condition.

Ld. Special PP-in-Charge raised objection against the prayer for bail.

I have heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused and the Ld. Special PP.

Perused the CD and materials on record including the statement of the VG recorded u/Sec.183 BNSS.

It appears from the statement of the victim girl recorded u/Sec.183 BNSS that there is no such allegation to attract offence under section 10 of POCSO Act against the present accused. Considering the above facts and circumstances and also considering the period of detention already suffered by the accused, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail.

Accused Md. Hamid @ Guru may find bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.8,000/- with two sureties of Rs.4,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of Ld. CJM Alipore.

If on bail, fix **03.10.2026** for appearance and IO's report.
