Today is fixed for appearance.

The petitioner /father Shri Prasenjit Pal is present before the Court with his Ld. Advocate.

From Order No. 3 dated 15.07.2026 passed by the Ld. District Judge, it appears that the present case is to proceed exparte against the O.P./mother.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner who moves the application u/s. 12 of the Guardians and Wards Act seeking direction upon the O.P. to produce the minor son Suvadip Pal before the Court on every first Saturday and third Saturday of every month for the purpose of interim visitation during the pendency of the case.

It is stated that the O.P./mother left her matrimonial abode with her minor son aged 6 years on 27.08.2025 without any justifiable cause making it inconvenient to the petitioner to take proper care of the child who is suffering from acute dust allergy. It is stated that the child is presently living with the O.P. at the place of residence of the O.P.

From the cause title of the application it appears that the residential address of the petitioner and the O.P. are under the same P.S. Namkhana in the District of South 24 Parganas. It is not mentioned in the instant application that the petitioner was refused to visit his minor child in the residential address of the O.P. Since admittedly the minor child is suffering from acute dust allergy, I do not find it would be appropriate to direct the O.P. to produce the minor child bimonthly before the Court. It would be in the best interest of the minor if the petitioner visits him in his present residential address. Accordingly, the prayer for interim visitation is allowed exparte at this stage after giving liberty to the petitioner to visit his minor son in the residential address of the O.P. every Sunday from 10.30 a.m. to 11.30 a.m. The respondent Anima Pal (Jana) shall ensure that the petitioner is given access to meet his minor child on the given day and time every week until further order.
