Record is put up on prayer of learned advocate for accused Kakuli Singh.

Accused **Kakuli Singh** surrendered before the Court and filed a petition alongwith vokalatnama praying for bail. She is taken into custody till 18.11.2023 due to ensuing Puja Vacation which will be commenced on 19.10.2023.

Heard both sides.

Learned advocate for the accused person submitted that this accused is innocent and has been implicated in this case falsely. She has complied the notice served by police u/s 41A Cr.P.C. Today She voluntarily surrendered before the Court. Thus, he prayed for bail of this accused person imposing any terms and conditions.

Learned Special P.P-in-Charge Nita Basu raised objection.

Perused the materials on record and CD including statement of the victim girl recorded u/s 164 of Cr.P.C.

It appears that accused has complied the notice served by police u/s 41A Cr.P.C as it reveals from the notice which has been placed before this Court. This accused person surrendered before this Court voluntarily. Considering the above fact bail prayer of accused stands allowed.

Accordingly, accused person namely **Kakuli Singh** may find a bail of Rs.2,000/-(rupees two thousand only) with two surety of Rs.1000/-(rupees one thousand only) each subject to satisfaction of learned C.J.M Alipore with condition that she shall attend the Court regularly as fixed by this Court i.d to J.C till 18.11.2023 due to ensuing Puja Vacation which will be commenced on 19.10.2023.

If on bail to date i.e. 06.02.2024 for appearance of accused person and I.O's report.
