Received original FIR, formal FIR, statements of complainant, victim boy, victim girl and denotation in five different sealed envelopes along with other documents from the I.O of this case.

Register the same as Special Case No. 452 of 2025 under section 64(2)(f) BNS and Section 6 of POCSO Act.

The I.O of this case has made prayers for recording statements of the victim girl, victim boy and complainant under section 183 B.N.S.S and medico-legal examination of the victim girl for the purpose of investigation.

Heard the I.O and learned Special P.P.

Prayers of the I.O are considered and allowed for interest of investigation.

Learned C.J.M., Alipore is requested to record the statements of the victim girl, victim boy and complainant under section 183 B.N.S.S either personally or by deputing any other Magistrate within 48 hours following the procedure as laid down in section 25 and 26 of the POCSO Act, 2012 and to forward the same to this Court without undue delay. In view of the direction of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta vide Judgment dated 16.12.2021 delivered by the Hon'ble Justice Bibek Chawdhuri in CRA 517 of 2017 (Prabir Bhuian Alias Prabir Bhuinyan Vs The State of West Bengal) the learned Magistrate is also requested to take care and to take necessary steps so that the identity of the victim girl and victim boy are not disclosed.

The I.O. of this case is directed to take further instruction from the learned Magistrate regarding the production of the victim girl, victim boy and complainant for recording their statements.

Supply copies of statements to the I.O as and when these are received.

Inform the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate by sending a copy of this order along with photocopy of F.I.R and formal F.I.R.

The Professor and Head of the Department, Forensic Science and State Medicine, N.R.S Medical College and Hospital, Kolkata is requested to make necessary arrangement for medico-legal examinations of the victim girl and victim boy. The medico-legal examination of the victim girl should be done under the supervision of a woman doctor. The examination shall be done following the procedure laid down by section 164A of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 (2 of 1974) and section 27 of the POCSO Act, 2012. The examination of the victim girl and victim boy should be done in presence of parents of the children or any other person in whom the children repose trust or confidence. If for any reason, the parents or the person in whom the children have confidence cannot be present in that event, medical examination of the victim girl shall be conducted in presence of a woman doctor nominated by the Head of the Medical Institution.

I.O is directed to produce the victim girl and victim boy to the concerned hospital on the scheduled date.
