Accused Md. Shamim (**40 years**) is produced before this Court from JC through VCS.

Today is fixed for hearing of the bail application. The same is taken up for hearing in presence of all sides.

Ld. Advocate for the accused moves the petition praying for bail by submitting that as per FIR there is no allegation u/Sec.6 of POCSO Act. Due to misunderstanding between the husband and wife this case has been filed raising false allegation. Accused person is in custody since 19.09.2025 about more than 75 days. If the accused is released on bail he will co-operate with the IO in the investigation.

Ld. Special PP is present and raised objection against the prayer for bail. Defacto complainant is present along with her Ld. Advocate. Both the defacto complainant and her Ld. Advocate submit that if the accused is released on bail they have no objection.

Heard all sides.

Considering the submission of all sides and on perusal of the case record and CD it appears that accused is in custody for more than 75 days and investigation is almost completed. Therefore, I do not find any reason for further detention of the accused in custody. Accordingly, prayer for bail is allowed.

Accused Md. Shamim may find bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5000/- with two sureties of Rs.2500/- each subject to the satisfaction of Ld. CJM Alipore.

If on bail, fix **15.07.2026** for appearance and IO's report.
