Accused Gopal Mondal (**21 years**) is produced from JC through VCS.

Accused Kalipada Mondal on CB is present by filing hazira.

Today is fixed for hearing of the bail petition filed on behalf of accused Gopal Mondal. The same is taken up for hearing in presence of all sides.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person has submitted that his client is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Ld. Advocate has further submitted that his client is in custody for a considerable period. Thus, he prayed for bail of the accused person in any condition.

Ld. Special P.P. raised objection against the prayer for bail.

Defacto complainant is personally present along with her Ld. Advocate. Defacto complainant raised strong objection against the prayer for bail.

Perused the CD, statement of the VG recorded u/Sec.183 BNSS and other materials in the case record.

It transpires from the CD including the statement of the VG recorded u/Sec.183 BNSS and medico legal examination report of the VG that there are sufficient incriminating materials against the accused showing his involvement in the commission of the offence. Thus having considered the nature and gravity of the offence, I am not inclined to enlarge the accused person on bail.

Hence, the prayer for bail is rejected. Let the accused Gopal Mondal be remanded to J/C till the next date.
