Bail moved on behalf of aforesaid accd.

Hd both sides. Perused.

It is submitted by ld. Defence counsel that he accd has been falsely entangled in this case and at the time of arrest the ground of arrest has not been communicated and his signature has been falsely procured on all the documents and in this facts & circumstances he prays for bail.

Ld. P.P in-charge strongly opposes the prayer for bail submitting inter-alia that in this case commercial quantity of narcotic substance has been involved.

Having considered the submission of both sides and having considered the entire materials on record this Court finds that in this case commercial quantity of narcotic substance have been involved. Thus in view of above specially considering the bar as provided in Section 37 NDPS Act prayer for bail stands rejected.
