Record is put up on prayer of learned advocate for accused Rohan Singh.

One bail petition has been filed on behalf of accused Rohan Singh.

Heard both sides.

Learned advocate moves bail application on behalf of accused Rohan Singh and submits that this accused is in custody for more than five years. The evidence of prosecution has almost completed. I.O has been cross examined in full on behalf of this accused and on the next date (20.02.2023) the learned advocate on behalf of accused Usha Singh will cross examine the I.O. So considering the detention accused may be granted bail imposing any terms and conditions. No bail prayer is either pending or rejected before any higher forum.

Learned Special P.P raises objection.

Perused the materials on record, evidence adduced by the victim girl and her aunt. It appears that the accused happened to be step father of the victim and the allegation against him is very serious in nature. Accused originally is residing at Maharashtra and evidence of the prosecution has almost completed. 20.02.2023 is fixed for further cross examination of I.O on behalf of accused Usha Singh. So at this stage I am not inclined to grant bail to this accused. Accordingly bail petition of accused is rejected.

To date i.e 20.02.2023 for production of accused and further cross examination of I.O (PW-6).
