Today is fixed for hearing bail petition of the accused persons namely Arpita Majumdar and Somnath Das dated 30.09.2022 (as the Puja Vacation intervened and 30.09.2022 was the last day before vacation).

Heard learned advocate for accused Arpita Majumdar and Somnath Das.

Learned advocates for the accused Arpita Majumdar and Somnath Das submitted that the vulnerable witnesses have already been examined. These accused persons are in custody since 01.11.2019 and there is no such serious involvement of these accused in this case. So accused may be granted bail on any condition.

Learned Special P.P raised objection.

Perused the materials on record.

The accused persons are in custody for a considerable period. Vulnerable witness have already been examined and other co-accused persons such as Arpita Das, Ruksana Bibi are enjoying their bail. Moreover, learned advocate appearing on behalf of Arpita Majumdar submitted that the petitioner has a minor son, aged about 3 ½ year who is under the custody of her grandfather who is seriously ill. Learned advocate for the accused further submitted that the bail prayer of this accused was rejected by the Hon'ble Court prior to framing of charges. Learned advocate appearing on behalf of accused Somnath Das submitted that no bail petition is pending or rejected before any higher forum. Moreover only allegation against him is that he took the victim in his motorcycle to the house of Arpita Das. So considering the above facts and circumstances, considering the detention of the accused person and also considering that the vulnerable witnesses have already been examined I am inclined to grant interim bail to these accused persons till 03.12.2022 on condition that they will attend the office of AHTU, DD once in fortnight till further order.

Accordingly, accused persons namely Arpita Majumdar and Somnath Das shall be released on A/I bail of Rs.5,000/-(rupees five thousand only) each with two surety of Rs.2500/- (rupees two thousand five hundred only) each till 03.12.2022 subject to satisfaction of learned C.J.M Alipore with condition that they will attend the office of AHTU, DD once in fortnight till further order, i.d to J.C.

If on bail to date i.e. 03.12.2022 for appearance of accused person and evidence.
