Furthermore, Ld. Advocate for the petitioner files an application u/s 12 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, duly supported by an affidavit, praying for visitation of the minors namely Eliza Mondal and Inaya Mondal and the same is taken up for hearing.

It appears from the record that no caveat has been filed.

Heard the submissions of Ld. Advocate for the petitioner.

Perused the application under section 12 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, which is supported by an affidavit, and the documents annexed thereto.

Considering the entire aspects of the matter and taking into account the submissions of Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, this Court is of the view that the petitioner/father deserves to have the right of virtual visitation with his minor daughters.

Hence,

it is,

ORDERED

that the prayer for an order of interim visitation is allowed in favour of the petitioner/father till **09.01.2026**.

The opposite party/mother is directed to produce the minor daughters

namely Eliza Mondal and Inaya Mondal, over virtual mode and the petitioner shall be allowed to converse with the minor daughters through video call on every Saturday & Sunday from 05:00 p.m. to 06:00 p.m.

At the time of visitation, the OP/mother will stay far and not disturb the petitioner/father so that the petitioner/father may meet with the minor daughters.

The petitioner/father and the opposite party/mother, being the parents, are expected to maintain proper decorum as per the direction of this Court.
