On hearing the submissions made by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, this Court is of the view that the petitioner, being the father, deserves to have the right of visitation with his minor son.

Hence,

it is,

ORDERED

that the prayer for an order of interim visitation is allowed in favour of the petitioner/father till **22.04.2025**.

The petitioner/father is given liberty to meet and interact with his son, Anirban Panigrahi, once in a week at Barakachari Temple on every Sunday at 10:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M. till 22.04.2026.

The respondent/mother is directed to produce the minor at the aforesaid place and time so that the petitioner can meet and interact with the minor.

The petitioner/father and the respondent/mother, being the parents of the minor, are expected to maintain proper decorum and to allow the minor to interact with his father as per the direction of this Court.

Fix **22.04.2026** for further hearing.

The petitioner is directed to apprise the respondent of this order so that they can comply with the same in true letter and spirit.
