Today is fixed for appearance of the petitioner.

Petitioner is present by filing hazira.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner files an application U/O. 6 R. 17 of CPC stating inter alia that the petitioner files the instant Matrimonial suit seeking dissolution of marriage U/S. 13 (1) (1a) and 13 (1) (ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 but due to some inadvertence Sec. 13 (1) (i) is also mentioned in the cause title as well as prayer portion of the instant Mat suit and prays for necessary correction to that effect as the petitioner has not sought for divorce on the ground of Sec. 13(1) (i) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

Heard the submission of the Ld. Advocate. Perused the petition and materials on record. Considered.

It is found that the proposed amendment is formal in nature and if the same would be allowed, it would not change the nature and character of the suit. On the other hand it is necessary, for the purpose of determining the real question of controversy between the parties.

In view of the aforesaid facts, the petition filed under Order 6 Rule 17 read CPC is considered and allowed.
