as follows:

First:- That you, on or about on 01.07.2019 at Quest Mall, Sayed Amir Ali Avenue under P.S. Karaya, Kolkata, which is a public way, in a manner so rash or negligent driving as to endanger human life and you thereby committed the offence punishable under section **279** of Indian Penal Code, and within (3) the cognizance of the court of Session.

- (3) My cognizance or the cognizance of the Court of Sessions.

Secondly :- That you, on or about on 01.07.2019 at Quest Mall, Sayed Amir Ali Avenue under P.S. Karaya, Kolkata, caused hurt to constable namely Tapan Oraon by doing an act by driving so rashly and negligently as to endanger human life and you thereby committed the offence punishable under section **337** of Indian Penal Code, and within (3) the cognizance of the court of Session.

- (4) In cases tried by Magistrate, omit by the said Court.

And I thereby direct that you be tried (4) by the said Court on the said charge

The said charge is read over and explained to the accused person to which he plead not guilty and claim to be tried.
