Police record produced. ASI Rashpal Singh no. 9/115, P.S. Anti Power Theft Verka, Amritsar has appeared in the court and made a separate statement that in this case the checking was conducted on 12.11.2018 and theft of electricity was effected. The demand notice of Rs. 8143/- was served and compounding charges of Rs. 720/- are also recoverable as per notice dated 15.11.2018. No other recovery is to be effected from the applicant.

Heard on bail application. The present case has been registered on the basis of allegations of theft of electricity which was detected during the checking conducted on 12.11.2018 and accordingly, the amount of Rs. 8143/- is stated to be recoverable as charges for theft of electricity along with compounding charges of Rs.720/-. The applicant has expressed his readiness to join the investigation and apart from the money, nothing else is stated to be recoverable from the applicant. As such, without commenting on the

merits of the matter, the applicant/accused is directed to join the investigation within 04 days from today and in the event of his arrest, he be released on interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the investigation/arresting officer on deposit of 50% of demand of Rs. 8143 i.e. Rs. 4072/- within seven days, subject to compliance of provision enshrined in Section 438 (2) Cr.PC. Bail application is adjourned to 01.08.2019 for report. IO is directed to produce the record on the next date of hearing.
