



**Order below Exh.1 in RCS No.61/2025 Madhavao Vs.
Bhagirathabai and Ors.**

Today plaintiffs, defendants and their learned advocates are present before the Court. Matter was referred for mediation to Adv. S. G. Ludge Patil. Mediation is successful. Mediator filed their mediation report Exh.12. Parties have filed compromise memo below Exh.13 stating that the matter has been compromised among them and plaintiff do not want to proceed further with this suit. I have read over and explained terms of compromise memo Exh.13 to parties to open Court. I have personally inquired to plaintiffs, defendants and their learned advocate about truthfulness of compromise memo. They have admitted contents and their signatures and thumb impressions over said compromise memo. I am satisfied about said compromise is lawful and voluntarily executed by the parties. Hence, the suit needs to be disposed of as compromised. Therefore, following order is passed.

ORDER

1. The suit is disposed of as compromised in view of Compromise memo below Exh.13.
2. Compromise memo Exh.13 be treated as part and parcel of decree.
3. Decree be drawn accordingly.
