He is not filing any written explanation or report, as to why, he has affixed the summons when nobody was residing at the given address. However, he only goes on to insisting verbally that, as per the instructions, as received from the office of Ld. ACJ, they are to affix the summons, whether or not, anybody are residing at the given address.

This kind of submission happens to be quite surprising and contrary to the relevant rules. However, notice be issued to the Incharge, Nazarat Branch, of the same district, to be present in person alongwith his written explanation, as to what, in these matters, makes it incumbent upon the Process Server to affix the summons, when the person concerned is reported to be not residing, at the given address.

List the matter for this purpose as well, on the date already fixed in the main case. However, Process Server Sh. D.P. Singh shall also continue to appear in person on the next date.
