A petition praying for adjournment is filed for the defendant on the ground that the defendants are in a different country and they could not return to India. Copy of the petition has been served to the Ld Advocate for the appellants who has put endorsement 'from strongly objected to' thereon.

Heard both sides on the adjournment petition.

Ld Advocate appearing for the respondent to move the petition prays for adjournment while the Ld Advocate for the appellants raises vehement objection against the prayer. He submits that the presence of the respondent is not required for examination of the Ld Advocate Commissioner against the prayer for adjournment and also prays for imposition of heavy cost in case the prayer for adjournment is allowed.

Perused the previous order in which there was a direction upon both sides to come ready on this day.

The prayer for adjournment is allowed as last chance with cost of Rs. 300/- (CP) to be paid by the defendants to the plaintiffs by the next date.

Both the parties are directed to come ready on the next date.
