Today is fixed for hearing of petition under Order 6 Rule 17 CPC.

The petitioner is represented through her Ld Advocate. The Respondent is absent without steps. On repeated calls, he is found absent. None moves.

Now the record is taken up for hearing of the petition U/o 6 Rule 17 CPC, wherein, it has been stated inter alia that she now intends to incorporate a new paragraph in place of existing paragraph No.5 which needs to be deleted and in the said new paragraph, it needs to be stated that the petitioner never resided with the respondent anywhere in India and never led a conjugal life. That her father came to know that the respondent had earlier married a lady namely Sukanya Bhattacharjee who lodged an FIR against the respondent resulting in a judgement and prayed for permission for carrying out the necessary amendment as per schedule of proposed amendment.

Perused materials on record including the instant petition under adjudication. It reveals that the facts sought to be incorporated are relevant facts which are necessary for proper adjudication of the matter and the prayer needs to be allowed for effective adjudication.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED

that the petition dt.17.02.2026 U/o 6 Rule 17 is allowed ex-parte without any order as to costs.

Fix 27.07.2026 for filing of amended plaint by the petitioner and for causing service upon the respondent both ways.
