3. Reply to the bail application was filed by the Investigating Officer, also forwarded by the Ld. Public Prosecutor appearing for the State.

Briefly stated, as per the case made by the investigating agency, on 13.06.2026, at about 07:00 P.M., ASI Sukhvir Singh along-with other police officials was present at Anti Narcotic Cell, Kurukshetra, when he received a secret information that co-accused Sardeep Singh @ Babbu was engaged in selling Heroin and country made liquor and he had kept a huge quantity of the same in the room situated in the cattle shed of his house or in car bearing registration No.HR32G-7133. Upon receiving this information, a raiding party, headed by ASI Sukhvir Singh, was constituted, which reached at the spot. During checking, co-accused Sardeep Singh @ Babbu was found having the possession of 48 bottles and 50 quarter of country made liquor make Masti Malta and 31.67 gm Heroin.

5. Accordingly, a tehrir was written and sent to the police station, basis on which, the instant criminal case was registered. Co-accused Sardeep Singh @ Babbu was arrested and during interrogation, he suffered a disclosure statement, implicating the present petitioner. Thereafter, the petitioner was booked for the commission of offence punishable under Section 29 of NDPS Act. He was lying in judicial custody since 16.06.2026. Therefore, he moved this application for regular bail.

6. I have heard the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the accused-petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor for the State.

7. The name of the present petitioner has surfaced in the disclosure statement suffered by co-accused Sardeep Singh @ Babbu, who

was caught red handed by the police team headed by ASI Sukhvir Singh on 13.06.2026, having the possession of 48 bottles and 50 quarter of country made liquor make Masti Malta and 31.67 gm Heroin. The petitioner has been booked for the commission of offence punishable under Section 29 of NDPS Act and no recovery has been affected from him. He was lying in custody since 16.06.2026. The quantity of the contraband (Heroin), allegedly recovered from the co-accused, was intermediate. The investigation as well as subsequent trial are likely to take a considerable time and the petitioner, who is already lying in custody since 16.06.2026, may not be kept behind bars for an indefinite period. Therefore, the bail application of the petitioner is hereby **allowed**, subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate. A copy of this order be sent to the Court of learned Illaqa Magistrate for information and necessary compliance and with the direction to forward the requisite bail bonds to this Court.

8. None of the opinion recorded above by this Court in the instant order would affect the merits of the case in any manner in future and the same are recorded only for the purpose of determination of application for bail. File be consigned to the record room after due compliance.
